NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain

Township, being known and designated as Lot 33 on plat of I. H.

Philpot, recorded in Plat Book T, Page 427, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Boyd Drive which pin is approximately 440 feet from the intersection of Boyd Drive and the Old White Horse Road; thence along the southern side of Boyd Drive,

N, 58-30 E. 83 feet to pin; thence with said Drive, N. 83-30 W. 85 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot 34; thence with the line of Lot 34,
