to demand, with respect to the withdrawal of any cash or any action whatsoever within the purview of this Indenture, any showings, certificates, opinions, appraisals or other information, or action or evidence thereof (in addition to that by the terms hereof required as a condition of such action) by the Trustee deemed desirable for the purpose of establishing the right of the County to the withdrawal of any cash, or the taking of any other action by the Trustee.

(k) The Trustee shall permit the holder of any bond to inspect any statement, instrument, opinion or certificate filed with the Trustee by the County or by any person, firm or corporation acting for the County.

Section 12.02. The Trustee may resign and be discharged from the trust created by this Indenture by delivering to the County notice in writing of such resignation, specifying a date when such resignation shall take effect, and by mailing a copy of such notice to each registered owner of bonds to his address as the same appears on the Bond Register not less than thirty days nor more than sixty days prior to the date so specified. Such resignation shall take effect on the day specified in such notice to the County unless previously a successor Trustee shall be appointed as hereinafter provided, in which event such resignation shall take effect immediately upon the appointment of such successor Trustee.

Section 12.03. Upon written request of the holders of fifty-one per cent in principal amount of the outstanding bond, the Trustee, may, subject to its right to compensation hereunder, be removed by the County by an instrument in writing in proper form for recordation, authorized by and set forth in full in a resolution of the County.
