MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS.

I, Ola F. Culbertson

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto Southern Bank and Trust Company Piedmont, S. C.

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Five hundred fifty-eight and 24/100-----

Dollars (\$ 558.24) due and payable

in twelve monthly payments of \$46.44 each, beginning on March 7, 1968 and payments continuing monthly thereafter until paid in full.

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be paid: in advance

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Grove Township, containing one acre,

more or less, Beginning at an iron pin in center of county road leading from the New Augusta Road past the former home of W. M. Stenhouse, deceased, at corner of land of Sue H. Earle, and running thence with Earle line N. 86-15 W. 325.7 feet to iron pin, Thomas Stenhouse line; thence with said Stenhouse line N. 3-45 E. 269 feet to iron pin center of said county road; and thence with the center of said road S. 46-40 E. 422.1 feet to the point of beginning, and being the same property conveyed to Ernest E. Floyd and Maybelle D. Floyd by Thomas Stenhouse by deed dated July 23, 1945, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book 278, page 142.

This is the same property conveyed to Leroy Culbertson and Ola F. Culbertson by deed of J. H. Tilson and Dorothy Tilson, dated May 6, 1947, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book 312, Page 1.

Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had thereform, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
