"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone on the Northwest side of the branch and running thence out a line, S. 20-30 E. 419.1 feet to a stone: thence at a line, S. 85-30- E. 815.1 feet to a point in the center of Beaver Dam Creek; thence down the said Creek at the center of the Creek as the line, 301 feet to a point; thence along a line, N. 37 W. 638.1. feet to a pine stump; thence along the line, S. 84-45 W. 891 feet to a stone, the beginning corner, being more fully described by a plat of property of H.
