"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon,

situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

being known as Lots 15, 16 and 17 as shown on a plat of Riverside recorded in Plat Book K at page 281, and when described as a whole having the following metes and bounds according to said plat:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Riverside Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 14 and 15 and running thence with the line of said lots, N 10-15 E 125 feet; thence S 79-45 E 150 feet; thence along the boundaries of Lots 17 and 18, S 10-15 W 125 feet; thence along Colonial Avenue, N 79-45 W 150 feet to the point of beginning.

Colonial Avenue is shown as Yellowstone Drive on the Tax Map and this property is further shown as Lots 17, 18 and 19 of Block 13 on the Greenville County Block Book System Map 146.
