"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Fountain Inn, on the Northeast side of Cherry Lane Drive with the following metes and bounds, according to plat by C. O Riddle, Surveyor, August 7, 1965: BEGINNING at iron pin on northeast side of Cherry Lane Drive, joint corner with lot of Mrs. Ethel R. Casey, thence with the northeast side of said Drive South 40-42 East 120 feet to iron pin, joint corner with Lot 2, thence with Lot 2 North 49-35 East 150 feet to iron pin, back joint corner with Lot 2 and on line of lands of C.
