BEGINNING attachiat an iron pin, joint corner of J. C. Jarrard and running thence N. 89 E. 219 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of P. D. Jarrard; thence N.  $\frac{1}{4}$  W. 100 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of P. D. Jarrard and D. W. Patterson; thence S. 89 W. 216 feet to an iron pin on right-of-way of G. & N. Railroad; thence with G. & N. Railroad right-of-way S.  $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
