at the rate of seven per cent, per annum, to be computed and , with interest thereon from maturity paid Semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, and being known and designated as Lot No. 4 of the property formerly owned by H. W. Hunt and surveyed by R. E. & Dalton, Engineer, and Plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" at Page 24 and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 3 on a 30 foot street (known as Gentry Street) and running thence with said street N. 24-00 E. 50 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot. No. 5; thence with said lot no. 5, S. 55.54 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the J. R. Chandler property; thence S. 34-00 W. 50 feet to an iron pin on Lot No. 3; thence N. 55.54 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner.
