NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 103 on plat of Farmington Acres, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book RR at pages 106-7, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwesterly side of Claxton Drive at joint corner of Lots 103 and 104 and running thence with common line of said lots, N 37-15 W 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N 52-45 E 90 feet to an iron pin; thence S 37-15 E 150 feet to an iron pin on the northwesterly side of Claxton Drive; thence with said Drive, S 52-45 W 90 feet to the point of beginning.

In addition to and together with the monthly payments of principal and interest under the terms of the note secured hereby, the mortgagor promises to pay to the mortgagee the sum of 1/48th of 1% of the original amount of this loan in payment of the mortgage guaranty insurance covering this loan and on his failure to pay it, the mortgagee may advance it for the mortgagors account and collect it as a part of the debt secured hereby. The mortgagors agree that after the expiration of 10 years from the date hereof, the mortgagee may at its option apply for mortgage insurance for an addition 5 year period with the mortgage insurance company insuring this loan, and the mortgagors agrees to pay to the mortgagee as premium for such Insurance 1/2 of 1% of the principal balance then existing.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
