WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon,

situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, at the Southwest corner of Birnie Street and Wardlaw Street, in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 1 on plat of property of Ladson A. Mills made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in May, 1930, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book G at Page 272 and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin 39.2 feet from the Southwest intersection of Birnie Street and Wardlaw Street, at corner of Lot No. 2, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 72-16 W. 81.2 feet to an iron pin line of Lot No. 13; thence with the line of said lot, N. 17-56 V. 49.1 feet to an iron pin on Birnie Street; thence with the Southern side of Birnie Street, N. 79-12 E. 81.9 feet to an iron pin at the Southwest intersection of Birnie Street and Wardlaw Street; thence with the Western side of Wardlaw Street, S. 17-56 E. 39.2 feet to the beginning corner.

LESS, HOWEVER, that triangular strip of property situate at the Southwestern corner of Lot no. 1 having previously been conveyed to the South Carolina Highway Department by deed dated January 15, 1966, and recorded in Deed Book 809 at page 511.
