NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand paid by second party, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release; in fee simple, unto second party, its successors and assigns, the following described lands, including but not limited to, all trees, timber, shrubbery, fixtures and improvements now and hereafter thereon:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Fairview Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, located on the Jenkins Bridge Road about five miles southwest of Fountain Inn, containing 294.55 acres, more or less, as shown on four plats prepared for John H. Harrison, Jr., on February 14, 1927, by C. M. Furman, Jr., and Maggie L. Harrison on December 18, 1926, by C. M. Furman, Jr., and Elbert P. Ridgeway in February, 1956, by C. O. Riddle and W. David Ridgeway, Jr., December 3, 1952, by C. O. Riddle, Surveyor, and having according to said plats the following courses and distances to-wit:

Wasson; thence south 26 degrees 15 minutes west 781.7 feet to a stake in the old Creek run, a corner of the 192-acre tract included herein; thence south 87 degrees 30 minutes east 51.61 chains to a stone; thence north 63 degrees 00 minutes west 18.95 chains to a stone; thence north 24 degrees 45 minutes east 15.20 chains to s tone; thence south 69 degrees 45 minutes east 47.84 chains to a red oak; thence south 26 degrees 45 minutes west 19.10 chains to a stake; thence south 22 degrees 00 minutes east 200 feet to an iron pin at the corner of property conveyed to W. David Ridgeway, Jr.; thence south 62 degrees 31 minutes west 457 feet to an iron pin; thence south 32 degrees 37 minutes east 1247 feet to a point in the middle of Jenkins Bridge Road, located 53.2 feet south 32 degrees 37 minutes east of an iron pin on the bank of said road; thence along said road south 87 degrees 00 minutes west 3.72 chains to a stone; thence still along said road south 54 degrees 45 minutes west 12.36 chains to the point of BEGINNING.
