That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, O'Neal Township, located on the Northern side of Highway No. 13h (Saluda Osp Road) and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING in the fork of Branch Waters of Beaver Dam Creek and runs thence S. 25 W., 20.55 chains (1356.30 feet) to a iron spike in the center of said road; thence with said road N. 82 E., 2 chains (132 feet) to an iron spike in road; thence N. 25-00 E., 19.10 chains (128.14 feet) to a spike in the branch waters of Thompson's Beaver Dam Creek; thence with the said creek N. 12.50 W., 1.91 chains (126.06 feet) to the beginning corner and containing 3.9 acres more or less.
