## REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE FOR SOUTH CAROLINA (INSURED LOANS TO INDIVIDUALS)

WHEREAS, the note evidences a loss to Borower in the principal amount specified therein, made with the purpose and intention that the Government, at any fitting, may easign the note and insure the payment thereof pursuant to the Consolidated Farmers Roma Administration Act of 1961, or Title V of the Houseing Act of 1942, and

WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, it may be assigned from time to time and each holder of the insured note, in turn, will be the insured lender; and

WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government will execute and deliver to the insured lender along with the note an insurance endousement insuring the payment of all amounts payable to the insured lender in connection with the lends, and WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government by agreement with the insurance and the insurance and the note is a specified portion of the payments on the note, to be designated the "annual charge"; and

WHEREAS, a condition of the insurance of payment of the note will be that the holder will forego his sights and remedies against Borrower and any others. WHERRAS, it is the purpose and intent of this instrument that, among other things, at all times when the note is held by the Government, or in the event the Government should assign the instrument without insurance of the note, this instrument shall be the purpose of the note, but when the note is held by an insured lender, this instrument shall not secure payment of the note or attach to the debt evidenced thereby, but as to the note and such debt shall constitute an indemnity mortgage to secure the Government against loss under its insurance endorsement by reason of any default by Borrower:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the westerly side of Cooley Bridge Road, Oneal Township, Greenville County, South Carolina and being the easterly portion of tract, containing 2.0 acres, more or less, according to plat of property or George W. Arnold, prepared by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, October 20, 1923 as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book OO at Page 129 and, having according to said plat the following metes and bounds to wit:
