"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of

Greenville, lying and being in the Piedmont Manufacturing Company Village in or near the Town of Piedmont, and being more particularly described as Lot No. 32, Section 3, as shown on a plat entitled "Property of Piedmont Mfg, Company, Greenville County, made by Dalton & Neves February 1950 and recorded in the R.M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "Y", Pages 2-5, inclusive. According to said plat said lot is also known as No. 3 Orr Hill Street and fronts thereon 85 feet.
