NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indubted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagoe in hand well and truly poid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

All those lots of land in the county of Greenville, state of South Carolina, known and designated as Lots Nos. 10, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 & 18, on plat of property of Walter B. Meaders, made by Jones Engineering Service, December 1968, lots Nos. 10, 12, 14, 16 & 18 fronting on the north side of Oak Drive, and lots 13, 15 and 17 fronting on the south side of Florida Avenue.

Together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attacked, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
