NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (33.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bergained, sold and re-lessed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its succession and assigns: "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon,

situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being shown as Lot No.

2 on plat of Monteith Heights made by Pickell and Pickell, March 28,
1936, recorded in Plat Book B at page 185 in the RMC Office for
Greenville County, and being further described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the southeastern corner of Potomac Avenue (Hassie Street) and Monteith Circle and running thence with the eastern side of Monteith Circle S 28-15 E 160 feet to a stake at the corner of Lot 3; thence with the line of said lot, N 58-15 E 75 feet to a stake at the corner of Lot No. 1; thence with the line of said lot, N 28-15 W 160 feet to a stake on Potomac Avenue; thence with the southern side of said Avenue S 58-15 W 75 feet to the beginning corner.
