TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and angular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful suthority to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomseever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:

- That he will promptly pay the principal of and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the said note, at the times and in the manner therein provided, or as modified or extended by mutual agreement in writing.
- 2. That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein, and also any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgageo by the Mortgagee, and for any other or further obligation or indebtedness due to the Mortgagee by the Mortgageor at any time hereafter; and that all sums so advanced shall be are interest at the same rate as the Mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing; and the lien of this mortgage securing such advances and readvances shall be superior to the rights of the holder of any intervening lien or encumbrance.
- 3. Without affecting the liability of any person obligated for the payment of any indebtedness secured hereby, and without affecting the rights of the Mortgagee with respect to any security not expressly released in writing, the Mortgagee may at any time, without notice or consent, make any agreement extending the time or otherwise altering the terms of payment of the indebtedness secured hereby.
- 4. That he will keep the improvements now existing or horeafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and other hezards, in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that he does hereby assign to the Mortgagee all such policies, and that all such policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of; and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee.
- 5. That he will keep all improvements now existing or hereafter erected upon the mortgaged property in good repair, and, in the case of a construction loan, that he will continue construction until completion without interruption, and should he fail to do so, the Mortgagea may, at its option, enter upon said premises, make whatever repairs are necessary, including the completion of any construction work underway, and charge the expenses for such repairs or the completion of such construction to the mortgage debt.
- 6. That the Mortgages may require the maker, co-maker or endorser of any indebtedness secured hereby to carry life insurance upon himself in a sum sufficient to pay all sums secured by this mortgage, designating the Mortgages as beneficiary thereof, and, upon failure of the Mortgager to pay the premiums therefor, the Mortgages may, at its option, pay said premiums, and all sums so advanced by the Mortgages shall become a part of mortgage debt.
- 7. That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, he will pay to the Mortgagee, on the first day of each month, until the indebtedness secured hereby is paid in full, a sum equal to one-twelfth of the annual taxes, public assessments and insurance premiums, as estimated by the Mortgagee, and, on the failure of the Mortgage, to pay all taxes, insurance premiums and public assessments, the Mortgagee may at its option; pay said items and charge all advances therefor to the mortgage debt.
- 8. That he hereby assigns all the rents, issuer, and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder; and should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument; then the Mortgagee shall have the right to have a receiver appointed of the rents, issues, and profits, who, after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceedings and the execution of his trust at receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues, and profits, toward the payment of the debt secured hereby."
- 0. That, at the option of the Mortgages, this mortgage shall become due and payable forthwith if the Mortgagor shall convey away said mortgaged premises, or if the title shall become vested in any other person in any manner whatnever other than by death of the Mortgagor, or, in the case of a construction loan, if the Mortgagor shall permit work on the project to become and remain interrupted for a period of fifteen (15) days without the written correct of the Mortgages.
- 10. It is agreed that the Mortgagor shall hold and enjoy the preinter above conveyed until there is a default-under this mortgage or in the note secured hereby. It is the true meaning of this instrument that if the Mortgagor shall fully perform all the terms, condition, and covernant of this mortgage, and of the note secured hereby, that then this mortgage shall be utterly null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. If there is a default in any of the terms; conditions or covernants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgages, all sums then owing by the Mortgagor to the Mortgages thall become immediately due and payable and this mortgage may be foreclosed, thould any legal proceedings be inclined for the foreclosed the mortgage, or should the Mortgages, though the Mortgage of the life to the premises described herein, or should the debt secured hereby (or any put thereof, be placed in the hands of an attorney at law for collection by not or otherwise, all both and appears focured by the Mortgages, and it reasonable attorney's fee, shall thereupon become due and psyable immediately or on demand, at the option of the Mortgages, as a part of the debt secured thereby, and may be recovered and collected hereinder.
