Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditations, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the tents, issues, and profits which may selec or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment flow or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgages, its successors and assigns forever

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgages foreyer, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomscever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:

- 1. That he will promptly pay the principal of and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the said note, at the times and in the manner therein provided. Privilege is reserved to pay the debt in whole, or in an amount equal to one or more monthly payments on the principal that are next due on the note, on the first day of any month prior to maturity; provided, however, that written notice of an intention to exercise such privilege is given at least thirty (30) days prior to prepayment; and, provided, further, that in the event the debt is paid in full prior to maturity and at that time it is insured under the provisions of the National Housing Act, he will pay to the Mortgages an insurance premium charge of one per centum (1%) of the original principal amount thereof, except that in no event shall ance prenum charge of one per centum (1x) of the original principal amount, actively except that it is overest made in a week state of the adjusted premium exceed the aggregate amount of premium charges which would have been payable if the mortages has continued to be insured until maturity; such payment to be applied by the Mortgage upon its obligation to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development on account of mortgage insurance.
- That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, he will pay to the Mortgages, on the first day of each month until the said note is fully peid, the following sums:
 - (a) An amount sufficient to provide the holder hereof with finds to pay the next mortgage insurance premium if this instrument and the note secured hereby are insured, or a monthly charge (in lieu of a mortgage insurance premium) if they are held by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, as follows:
 - (f) if and so long as said note of even date and this instrument are insured or are reinsured under the provisions of the National Housing Act, as shound sufficient to accumulate in the hands of the holder one (1) month prior to its due date the annual motigage insurance premium, in order to provide such holder with funds to pay such premium to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development pursuent to the National Housing Act, as amended, and applicable Regulations thereunder; or
 - (II) If and so long as said note of even date and this instrument are held by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, a monthly charge (in 11eu of a mortages insurance premium) which shall be in an amount equal to one-twelfth (1/12) of one-helf (%) per centum of the average outstanding balance due on the note computed without taking ouencles or prepayments:
 - (b) A sum equal to the ground reals, if any, next due, plus the presiums that will next become due and payable on policies of life and other harsed insurance covering the mortgaged property, plast states and assessments next due on the nortgaged property (all as estimated by the Mortgagee) less all sums already paid therefor divided by the number of months to elspes before one (1) month prior to the date when such ground reals, premiums, taxes, and assessments will become delinquent, such sums to be held by Mortgagee in trust to pay sald ground cents, premiums, taxes, and assessments will become delinquent.
 - (c) All payments mentioned in the two preceding subsections of this paragraph and all payments to be made under the nois secured hereby shall be added together and the aggregate amount thereof shall be paid by the Morigagor each month in a single payment to be applied by the Morigagoe to the following items in the order set forth:
 - argus under the contract of insurance with the Secretary of Housing and Urban Davelopment, or monthly charge (in lieu of mortgage insurance premium), as the case may be;
 (ii) taxes, special assessments, fire and other hazard insurance premiums;

 - (III) interest on the note secured hereby; and (IV) amortization of the principal of said note.

Any deficiency in the amount of any such aggregate monthly payment, shall, unless made good by the Mortgagor prior to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an eyent of defents under this mortgage. The Mortgages may collect a "late charge" not to exceed two cents (2.9) for each doller (31) of each payment more than fifteen (15) days in arreers to cover the extra expense involved in handling delinquent payments."

3. If the total of the payments made by the Mortgagor under (b) of paragraph 2 preceding shall exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgagee for taxes or assessments or inaurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess shall be credited by the Mortgagee on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor. If, however, the monthly payments made by the Mortgagor under (b) of paragraph 2 preceding shall not be sufficient to pay taxes and assessments and insurance premiums, when the same shall become due and payable, then the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee any amount necessary to make up the deficiency; on or before the date when payment of such taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums shall be due. If at any time the Mortgagor shall lender to the Mortgage, taxes, assessments, or insurance presiums shall be due. If at any time the Mortgage, all lender to the Mortgage, in accordance with the provisions of the note secured hereby, full payment of the sottre indebtadness represented thereby, the Mortgagee shall, in computing the amount of such indebtadness, credit to the account of the Mortgage all payments made under the provisions of (a) of paragraph 2 hereof which the Mortgage has not become obligated to pay to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, and any balance remaining in the funds accumulated under the provisions of (b) of paragraph 2 hereof 3.11 their shall be a detail under any of the provisions of this mortgage resulting in a public sale of the premises covered interpr.
