Mable H. Ward and her heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain parcel or lot of land situated on the northwestern side of Enores Court, near Chick Springs, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being Lot No. 14 on a plat of Enores Heights, dated August, 1960, by J. Mac Richardson, R.L.S., recorded in Plat Book RR, page 63, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:
