TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, including all heating, plumbing and electrical fixtures, and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected or fitted in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than household furniture, be considered a part of the realty.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is selzed of the above described premises in fee simple absolute; that the above described premises are free and clear of all liens or other encumbrances; that the Mortgagor is lawfully empowered to convey or encumber the same; and that the Mortgagor will forever defend the said premiser unto the Mortgage, its successors and assigns, from and against the Mortgagor and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:

- 1. That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage will secure the Mortgagee for any additional sums which may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, or public assessments, hazard insurance promiums, repairs or other such purposes pursuant to the provisions of this mortgage, and also for any loans or advances that may hereafter be made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgage under the authority of Sec. 45-55, 1902 Code of laws of South Carolina, as amended, or similar statules; and all sums so advanced shall be an Interest at the same rate as that provided in said note and shall be payable at the demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That Mortgagor will keep the improvements on the mortgaged premises, whether now existing or hereafter to be exceed, insured against loss by fire, windstorm and other luzards in a sum not less than the balance due hereunder at any time and in a company or companies acceptable to the Mortgageve, and Mortgagor does hereby assign the policy or policies of insurance to the Mortgagee; and surgeres that all such policies shall be held by the Mortgagee and surgered to the Mortgagee; and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give immediate notice thereof the Mortgagee by registered mail; and should the Mortgagor at any time fail to keep said premises insured or fail to pay the premisura for insurance, then the Mortgage emay cause such improvements to be insured. The name of the Mortgagor and reimburse itself for the cost of such insurance, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged premiers in good repair, and should Mortgagor fail to do so, the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upon said premises and make whatever repairs are necessary and charge provided.
- 5. That the Mortgagee-may at any time require the issuance and maintenance of insurance upon the life of any person obtenedicans, and if the premiums are not otherwise paid, the Mortgagee as become a part of the mortgage debt.
- 6. That Mortgagor agrees to pay all taxes and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged premises on or before the due dates thereof and to exhibit the receipts therefor at the offices of the Mortgage immediately upon payment, and should the Mortgager fail to pay such taxes and assessments when the same shall fall due, the Mortgage may at its option, pay the same and charge the amounts so pald to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as above provided.
- 7. That if this mortgage secures a "construction loan", the Mortgagor agrees that the principal amount of the indebtedness hereby secured shall be distursed to the Mortgagor in periodic payments, as construction progresses, in accordance with terms and conditions of a Construction Loan Agreement which is separately executed but is made a part of this mortgage and incorporated herein by reference.
- 8. That the Mortgagor will not further encumber the premises above described, nor alienate said premises by way of mortgage or deed of conveyance without the prior consent of the Mortgagee, and should the Mortgagor so encumber or alienate such premises, the Mortgagee may, at its option, declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.

That the Mortgagor hereby assigns to the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, all the rents, issues, and profits accruing from the mortgaged premises, retaining the right to collect the same so long as the debt hereby secured is not in arrears of payment, but should any part of the principal indebtedness, or interest, taxes, or fire insurance premiums, be past due and unpaid, the Mortgagee may without notice or further proceedings take over the mortgaged premises, if they all the occupied by a tenant or tenants, and collect said rents and profits and apply the same to the indebtedness hereby secured, without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected, ests the cost of collection, and any tennal is authorized, upon request by Mortgagee, to make all rental payments direct to the Mortgagee, without liability to the Mortgager, until most official to occupied by the Mortgager, and should stall premises at the time of such default be occupied by the Mortgager, the Mortgagee may apply to the Judge of the County Court or to any Judge of the Count of Common Pleas who shall be residented preseding in the county aforesaid for the appointment of a receiver with authority to take possession of said premises and collect such rents and profits, applying said rents, after paying the cost of collection, to the mortgage debt without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected.

That if the indebtedness secured by this mortgage be guaranteed or insured by mortgage guaranty insurance, the Mortgager agrees to pay to the Mortgager, or the first day of each month until the role secured hereby is fully paid, the following sums in addition to the 'payments of principal and interest provided in said note: a sum equal to the premiums that will next become due and payable on policities of fire and other hazard insurances as sum equal to the property, plus taxes, and assessments next due on the mortgaged premises (all as estimated by the Mortgager) less all sums already paid therefor, divided by the number of months to elapse before one months of the date when such premiums, taxes, and assessments should these payments exceed the amount of payments actually made by the said premiums, taxes and special seasonsments.
