- (15) The Government may extend and defer the maturity of and renew and resmortize the debt syldenced by the note or any indebtedness to the Government accured hereby, release from Hability to the Government any party so liable thereon, release portions of the property from and subordinate the line hereof, and waive any other right hereunder, without affecting the line no priority hereof or the Hability to the Government of Borrower or any other party for payment of the note or indebtedness secured hereby except as specified by the Government in writing.
- (16) If at any time it shell appear to the Government that Borrower may be able to obtain a loss from a production credit association, or Federal land bank, or other responsible cooperative or private credit source, at reasonable rates and terms for loss for loss for calling purposes and periods of time, Borrower will, upon the Government's request, apply for and accept such loss in sufficient amount to pay the note and any indebtedness secured hereby and to pay for any stock necessary to be purchased in a cooperative lending agency in connection with such loss.
