TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, including all heating, plumbing and electrical fixtures, and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected or fitted in any manner, it being the inherition of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than household furniture, be considered a part of the realty.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is seized of the above described premises for fee simple absolute; that the above described premises are free and clear of all liers or other encumbrances; that the Mortgagor is lawfully empowered to convey or encumber the same; and that the Mortgagor will forever defend the said premiser but to the Mortgage, this successors and assigns, from and against the Mortgagor and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

The Morigagor covenants and agrees as follows:

- That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage will secure the Mortgagee for any additional sums which may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, or public assessments, hazard insurance premiums, repairs or other such purposes pursuant to the provisions of this mortgage, and also for any loans or advances that may hereafter be made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgager under the authority of Sec. 45-55, 1902 Code of laws of South Carolina, as amended, or similar statutes, and all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as that provided in said note and shall be payable at the demand of the Mortgager, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That Mortgagor will keep the improvements on the mortgaged premises, whether now existing or hereafter to be erected, insured against loss by fire, windsform and other hazards in a sum not less than the balance due hereunder at any time and in a company or companies acceptable to the Mortgage, and Mortgagor does hereby assign the policy or policies of insurance to the Mortgagege and agrees that all such policies shall be held by the Mortgagege assign the local clauses in favor of the Mortgage; and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give immediate note them to the Mortgage by registered mail; and should the Mortgagor at any time fall to keep said premises insured or foll to pay the premisurs for gard insurance, then the Mortgage may cause such improvements to be insured in the name of the Mortgager and relimburse itself for the cost of such insurance, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged premises in good repair, and should Mortgagor fail to do so, the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upon said premises and make whatever repairs are necessary and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as hereinabove
- 5. That the Mortgagee may at any time require the issuance and maintenance of insurance upon the life of any person obligated under the indebtedness secured hereby in a sum sufficient to pay the mortgage debt, with the Mortgagee as beneficiary, and if the premiums are not otherwise paid, the Mortgage may pay said premiums and any amount so paid shall become a part of the mortgage debt.
- 6. That Mortgagor agrees to pay all taxes and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged premises on or hefore the due dates thereof and to exhibit the receipts therefor at the offices of the Mortgager immediately upon payment, and should the Mortgagor fail to put such taxes and assessments when the same shall fall due, the Mortgage may at its option, pay the same and charge the amounts so paid to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as above provided.
- 7. That if this mortgage secures a "construction loan", the Mortgagor agrees that the principal amount of the indebtedness hereby secured shall be disbursed to the Mortgagor in periodic payments, as construction progresses, in accordance with terms and conditions of a Construction Loan Agreement which is separately executed but is made a part of this mortgage and incorporated herein by reference.
- 8. That the Mortgagor will not further encumber the premises above described, nor alienate said premises by way of mortgage or deed of conveyance without the prior consent of the Mortgage, and should the Mortgager so encumber or alienate such premises, the Mortgager may at its option, declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.

  9. That the Mortgager hereby assigns to the Mortgagee, its aucessors and assigns, all the rents, issues, and profits accruing from the mortgaged premises, retaining the right to collect the same so long as the debt hereby secured is not in arrears of payment, but should any part of the principal indebtedness, or interest, taxes, or fire insurance premiums, he past due and unpuld, the Mortgagee may without notice or further proceedings take over the mortgaged premises, if they should be occupied by a fenant or tenants, and collect said rents and profits and apply the same to the indebtedness hereby secured, without inhibity to account for anything more than the rents and profits and apply the same to the indebtedness hereby secured, without liability to account for anything more than the rents and should said premises at the time of such default be occupied to mortgager, until indified to the contrary by the Mortgagee, and should said premises at the time of such default be occupied to Mortgage, the Mortgagee may apply to the Judge of the County Court or to any Judge of the Court of Common Pleus with shall be recisient or presiding in the county aforesaid of the appointment of a receiver with authority to take possession of said premises and collect such rents and profits, applying said rents, after paying the enst of collection, to the mortgage debt without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected.

That if the indebtedness secured by this mortgage be guaranteed or insured by mortgage guaranty insurance, the Mortgager agrees to pay to the Mortgager on the first day of each month until the note secured hereby is fully paid, the following sums in addition to the payments of principal and interest provided in said note: a sum equal to the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes, and assessments next due on the mortgaged premises (all as estimated by the Mortgagee) loss all asms already payd therefor, divided by the number of months to clapse before one month prior to the date when such premiums, taxes, and dasessments will be due and payable, such sums to be held by Mortgagee to pay said premiums, taxes and special assessments, blould these payments exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgage for taxes, assessments, if, however, said sums shall be insufficient to make said payments when the same shall bear due and by the Mortgager and the same shall bears from the date hereof, Mortgagee may, at its option, apply for renewal of mortgage guaranty or similar insurance covering the balance then remaining due on the mortgage debt, and the Mortgagor may, at its option, pay the single permium required for the remaining years of the term, or the Mortgagee may as the premium and add the same to the mortgage debt, in which event the Mortgager shall repay to Mortgagee such premium and made the same to the mortgage debt, in which event the Mortgager shall repay to Mortgagee such premium and add the same to the mortgage debt, in which event the Mortgager shall repay to Mortgage may pay ment period.
