"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being on the southwestern side of Apopka Avenue, near the city of Greenville and being shown and designated as Lot #32 on a plat of Paris-Piney Park made by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer dated June, 1926, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, south Carolina in Plat Book H at page 20, reference to said plat being craved for a more complete and detailed description thereof.
