A Portion of that certain parcel or tract of land situate on the South-Western side of U.S. Highway No. 176, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown on a plat of the property of William A. Henson, dated June 25, 1952, (Revised Oct 6, 1955) prepared by H. B. Frankenfield, Jr., recorded in Plat Book Y at Page 77 in the RMC Office for Greenville County and having according to the said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southern side of U.S. Highway No. 176, leading from Tryon to Spartanburg, which point is South 56 degrees E. 49 feet from a point in the North Carolina - South Carolina State Line, on the same side of the Highway, and runs thence along the Southern Side of said Highway South 55 E. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 50-30 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 46-E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 43-30 E. 35 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 43 - 01 E. 30 feet to an iron pin at the corner of property now or formerly belonging to Floyd C. Henson; thence leaving the highway and running with the Henson property S. 46-51 W. 86.1 feet to an iron pin: thence N. 52-45 W. 205.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 3-14 E 125 feet to the point of BEGINNING.
