WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, it may be assigned from time to time and each holder of the insured note, in turn, will be the insured lender; and

WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government will execute and deliver to the insured lender along with the note an insurance endorsement insuring the payment of all amounts payable to the insured lender in connection with the loan; and WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government by agreement with the insured lender set forth in the insurance endorsement may be entitled to a specified portion of the payments on the note, to be designated the "annual charge"; and WHEREAS.
