SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said Edward J. Phillips and Martha B. Phillips in and by our certain promissory note in writing of even date with these Presents, are well and truly indebted unto the Citizens Building and Loan Association, Greer, S. C., in the full and just sum of fifteen thousand and no/100 - - - - - - (\$15,000.00) Dollars, with interest from the date hereof at the rate of eight per cent (8%) per annum, unpaid interest to bear interest at the same rate, to be repaid in installments of

C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to us the said mortgagor_s in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, Greer, S. That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on South Carolina Highway 93 (Noe Road), and being known and designated as Tract No. 6 on a plat of property of W. H. Alford; recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "BBB", at page 183, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:
