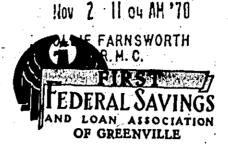

One Hundred Ninety-Two and 96/100(\$ 192.96 ) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable 25 years after date; and	i t
WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become imprediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the circumstant to interest the option of the holder thereof.

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagoe for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, fronting on Davidson Road and being known as the northern portion of Lot 91 on Plat No. 2 of the Parker Land Company's property as shown on plat thereof being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at Page 277 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at the corner of property now or formerly owned by McSwain and in the center of Davidson Road and running thence along the center of said road, N. 30-49 E. 51.5 feet to a bend in said road; thence continuing N. 53-35 E. 70 feet to a point; thence continuing with said road, N. 66-03 E. 217.9 feet; thence continuing with said road, N. 68-50 E. 100 feet to the corner of property now or formerly owned by Gambrell; thence S. 12-15 E. 446 feet to an iron pin on the line of property now or formerly owned by McSwain; thence N. 64-30 W. 521.7 feet to Davidson Road, the point of beginning; and containing approximately 2.3 acres; said property is the same conveyed to me by Robert H. Eppes and Mary R. Eppes by deed dated October 14, 1968 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. Page 299."
