TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgager further covenants to warrant and forever desend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
