seven per centum ( 7 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of C. Douglas Wilson & Company

in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of --ONE HUNDRED FIVE and 89/100-- Dollars (\$ 105.89), commencing on the first day of June, 19 71, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of May, 2001.

Now, Know All Men, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot 60 on plat of BELMONT HEIGHTS recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "GG" at pages 54 and 55, and a recent plat dated March 29, 1971, prepared by Carolina Surveying Company entitled "Property of L. J. Lockaby & Marsha Lynn Lockaby".

According to said plat this lot fronts 70 feet on the southwesterly side of Cool Brook Drive with a depth of 173 feet on one side and a depth of 148 feet on the other side and being 70.5 feet across the rear.
