ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 38 acres, more or less, being a part of the L. M. Nash Old Home Place, and having, according to a plat of the property prepared by J. A. Adams on March 31, 1917, and a plat of the eastern boundary of the property prepared by H. S.
