"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville

Greenville Township, known and designated as the western half of Lot

No. 9, of the subdivision known as "Augusta Circle". Plat of same is recorded in Plat Book F, Page 23, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

BEGINNING on northeast corner of Augusta Drive and Faris Road; thence with Faris Road N. 20-16 E. 160 feet to corner of lot no. 8; thence S. 55-15 E. 50 feet; thence S. 20-16 W. 160 feet to Augusta Drive; thence with Augusta Drive N. 55-15 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
