"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northern-side of Boykins Court, being shown as Lot no. 34 on a plat of Richmond Hills Subdivision, Section no. 5, dated October 20, 1968, prepared by R.B. Bruce, recorded in Plat Book WWW at page 38 in the RMC Office for Greenville County; and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
