NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and elso in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Ward 5 of the City of Greenville, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Lindburgh Avenue, joint corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8, and running thence S. 53-0 E. 157.2 feet to an iron pin at joint corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8; thence S. 21-28 W. 49.5 feet along line of J. W. Berry to an iron pin; thence along rear line of Lots Nos. 9, 10, 11 and 12, N. 53-0 E. 170.5 feet to an iron pin on Lindburgh Avenue; thence N. 37-00 E. 48 feet to the beginning corner, and being known as Lot No. 8 of the L.
