All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot no. 48 on a plat entitled Pelham Estates, Section III, recorded in Plat Book 4G at page 13 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
