WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of ______Twenty-eight Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty and no/100----- DOLLARS

(\$28,950.00----), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date, bearing interest as stated in said note, and payable as therein stated or as modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is Thirty--- years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced or readvanced to or for the Mortgagor's account, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being shown as Lot 13 on plat entitled "Addition to Del Norte Estates, Section IV, "recorded in Plat Book 4N at page 10 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southern side of Del Norte Road at the joint front corner of Lot 14 and running thence with line of Lot 14, S 52-18 W 188.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S 84-57 E 190.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S 84-35 E 21.38 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of Lot 12; thence with line of Lot 12, N 5-22 E 140 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Del Norte Road; thence with the southern side of said Road, N 84-35 W 15.7 5 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Del Norte Road, the chord of which is N 83-35 E 60 feet to the beginning corner.

Derivation: Same property conveyed to the mortgagors by Advance Builders, Inc., of Greenville, to be recorded herewith.

The mortgagors agree that after the expiration of ten years from the date hereof, mortgagee may at its option apply for mortgage insurance for an additional period of 5 years with the mortgage insurance company insuring this loan, and the mortgagors agree to pay to mortgagee as premium for such insurance 1/2% of the principal balance then existing.

In addition and together with the monthly payments of principal and interest under the terms of the note secured hereby, mortgagors promise to pay to mortgagee the sum of 1/48% of the original amount of this loan in payment of the mortgage guaranty insurance covering this loan and on their failure to pay it, mortgagee may advance it for mortgagors' account and collect it as a part of the debt secured by the mortgage.
