C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina. County of Greenville, O'Neal Township, about four miles northwest from Greer, lying on the northern side of the road that leads from the Buncombe Road to and by Jubilee Church, and being a part of tract No. 21 as shown on plat of property of J. B. Brookshire Estate prepared by H. L. Donahoo September 23, 1946 and being a part of the same lot that was conveyed to Butler Greer by deed from Wayne Brookshire recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and being further shown as lot No. 3 in a subdivision of the said lot No. 21, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING on an iron pin on the northern bank of the said road, joint corner of the Bill Ellison lot of the Brookshire land, and runs thence southwest 225 feet to the beginning corner of the lot being conveyed, and runs thence with the dividing line of lots 2 and 3 in the new subdivison N. 33-00 W. 211 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 64-29 W. 90 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 3 and 4; thence with the dividing line of lots 3 and 4 S. 30-20 E. 208 feet to iron pin on the northern bank of the said road; thence N. 64-23 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner, and containing one half (0.50) acres, more or less.
