NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, percel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of GREENVILLE, in the Town of Mauldin, and shown as Lot 17 on a Plat of property of J. W. Whitt, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book WW, Pages 74 and 75, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Pleasant Drive, at joint front corner of lots 16 and 17 and running thence with the joint line of said Drive, N. 29-45 W., 191.4 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 60-38 W., 66.4 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 24-10 E., 192.55 ft. to an iron pin on the Northern side of Pleasant Drive; thence with the side of said Drive, N. 66-45 E., 85 ft. to an iron pin at the point of beginning.
