together with all rights, interests, easements, hereditaments and appurtenences thereunto belonging, the watts, issues, and profits thereof and revenues and income therefrom, all improvements and personal property new or later attached thereto or reasonably necessary to the use thereof, including, but not limited to, ranges, refrigerators, or carpeting purchased or financed in whale or in part with less financed, water rights, and water stock pertaining thereto, and all payments at any time ewing to Berrewer by wittee of any sale, lease, transfer, conveyance, or condemnation of any part thereof or interest therein—all of which are herein called "the property usto the Government and its assigns forever.
