MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, I, Elbert Foster --

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted un to B.P. Edwards

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of

Two thousand nine hundred ten and no/100- - - - Delians (\$ 2,910.00 ) due and payable \$50.00 per month until principal and interest are paid in full-

with interest thereon from date at the rate of oight per centum per annum, to be paid: annually from date hereof

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Chicks Springs Township, and being bounded by the lands of Kirbie Bridwell and Mrs. Pearl Bridges Bridwell on the Southand by the lands of Simon Foster on the west and north and east and having the following meters and bounds to wit:

the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at a large stone on Mrs.Pearl Bradges Bridwell Line and running thence N 57 E 4.57 chains to iron pin on other lands of Foster, thence S 25 3/4t E 4.36 chains to iron pin near Simon Fosters barn; thence S 30 1/2 W 3.96 chains to iron pin on little road leading from highway to Fosters home; thence N 33 W 2.31 chains to an old decaying stump, joint corner of Simon Foster, Kirbie Bridwell and Mrs. Pearl Bridges Bridwell; thence N 40 1/4 W 3.26 chains to the beginning corner and containing two acres, more or less, according to survey of said land made by J. Earle Freeman on November 22,1941. This being all of the same tract of land conveyed to me by Simon Foster on the 17th. day of January 1942.

Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had thereform, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever tawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
