WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagoe for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW. KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being shown and designated as Lot No. 12, of a subdivision known as "Buxton" according to a plat entitled "Buxton" by Piedmont Engineers and Architects which is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "4 N", at Pages 2, 3, and 4, and according to a plat entitled "Revision of Lots 12 and 13, Buxton", by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, dated March 28, 1972, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "4 M", at Page 203, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of Winsford Drive at the joint front comer of Lots Nos. 12 and 31, and running thence along Winsford Drive, N. 36-30 W. 95.0 feet to an iron pin; thence with the intersection of Winsford Drive and Norwich Drive, N. 8-50 E. 35.2 feet to an iron pin on the southeastern side of Norwich Drive; thence with Norwich Drive, N. 44-56 E. 132.0 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 12 and 13; thence with the joint line of Lots Nos. 12 and 13, S. 43-10 E. 120.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 46-38 W. 171.3 feet to an iron pin, the point of BEGINNING.
