That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina. County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, in the City of Green, situate on the West side of Spring Street, being all of Lots Nos. 12 and 13 on a plat of land made for the Dobson Lumber Company by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated Oct. 28, 1944, and having the following courses and distances; (Plat book K page 299)

BEGINNING on a stake on the West side of Spring Street, the common corner with Lot No. 11, and runs thence with the line of Lot No. 11 N. 60 W. 150.2 feet to a stake, common corner of lots 4, 5, 11 and 12; thence with the back line of Lot No. 4 and 5, 100 feet S. 8.32 W. to a stake, corner of Lot No. 14; thence with the line of Lot No. 14 S. 80 F., 146.4 feet to a stake on the West side of Spring Street, thence with the West side of said Street N. 10.08 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
