And said mortgager agrees to keep the building and improvements now standing or hereafter erected upon the mortgaged premises and any and all apparatus, fixtures and input other hazards as the mortgage may from time to time require, all such insurance to be in forms, in companies and in suchs (not less than sufficient to avoid any claim on the part of the insurance to be in forms, in companies and in suchs (not less than sufficient to avoid any claim on the part of the insurers for consumance) satisfactory to the mortgage, and that at least fifteen days before the expiration of each such policy, a new and sufficient policy to take the place of the one so expiring shall be delivered to the mortgage.
