"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying and being in Gantt Township, lying on the Western side of Piedmont Road (Old National Highway No. 29) being shown as part of Tract No. 25 on a Plat of the property of E. A. Smythe, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book D at Page 170, and having according to a more recent plat thereof prepared by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, dated March 29, 1947, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of National Highway No. 29, joint front corner of Tracts Nos. 24 and 25, and running thence along the line of Tract No. 24 N. 83-42 W. 150 feet to point on said line; thence in a line parallel with the West side of said Highway No. 29 N. 6-40 E. 75 feet to a point; thence in a line parallel with the dividing line of Tracts Nos. 24 and 25, S. 83-42 E. 150 feet to a point on the West side of said National Highway; thence along the West side of said highway S. 6-40 W. 75 feet to point of beginning.

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the rear corner of the above described property (said iron pin being located 175 feet from the center of Piedmont Road) and running thence along the line of property now or formerly owned by Welborn, N. 83-42 W. 394.3 feet to an iron pin on the right-of-way of Southern Railway Co.; thence along said right-of-way N. 9-35 E. 75.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 83-42 W. 382 feet along the line of property now or formerly owned by Ginn to an iron pin; thence along to line of the immediately above described property S. 6-40 W. 75 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
