"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the western side of Blackgum Court in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina being shown as Lot 18 on a plat of Holly Springs Subdivision Section 1, dated February 23, 1971, prepared by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, recorded in Plat Book 4N at Page 5 in the RMC Office for Greenville County and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds TO-WIT:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Blackgum Court at the joint front corner of Lot 17 and 18 and running thence with Lot 17 N. 79-47 W. 99.34 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lot 16 and Lot 17; thence with Lot 16 and Lot 15 N. 79-43 W. 145 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lot 12 and Lot 18; thence with Lot 12 S. 13-16 W. 105 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lot 18 and Lot 19; thence with Lot 19 S. 84-02 E. 149.1 feet to an iron pin at the corner of a cemetary; thence with said cemetary S. 57-55 E. 96 feet to an iron pin on Blackgum Court; thence with said Court N. 21 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence still with said Court N. 12-30 E. 80 feet to the point of beginning.
