"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Western side of Stonehaven Drive, being shown and designated as Lot No. 61 on a Plat of the Property of Edward H. Hembree, which is a revision of Lots Nos. 111 and 112 as shown on Plat of the Property of Tully P. Babb, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book MMM, Page 168, and being composed of the Southern one-half of Lot No. 111 and Lot No. 112 and being described as follows:
