are well and truly indebted to Myrtle T. Alewine, Aileen Odom, George W. Alewine, Jr., Leland J. Alewine, William Ray Alewine, Fannie Neil A. Madden, Margaret A. Kennedy, Mildred A. Roberts, Annie Ruth A. Wallis, Henry Earla Alewine, Jr., James F. Alewine, Ethel V. Alewine, Martin Angel Alewine, Walter C. Alewine and Francis T. Alewine, partners trading as Taylor's Lumber Company, in the full and just sum of Two Hundred Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Seventeen and 50/100 (\$208,17.50) Dollars, in and by our certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith, due and payable as set forth in note of even date herewith

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said John C. Cothran, Ellis L. Darby, Jr., and M. Graham Proffitt, III, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said mortgagees, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that parcel or tract of land situate on the south side of Old Spartanburg Road in Chick Springs Township, five miles east of the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina and having, according to a survey made by G.O. Riddle, September, 1972, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville, S.C., in Plat Book 2, S. 5, Page 600; the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of Old Spartanburg Road at the corner of property now or formerly of Hazel H. Guest and running thence along said Old Spartanburg Road S 75-45 E 457.5 foot to an iron pin; thence still along Old Spartanburg Road S 86-10 E 1014.5 foot to an iron pin; thence along the center line of State Road S 23-312, S 53-58 E 1360.9 foot to an iron pin at the corner of property now or formerly of Francois E. Arnold and Wylma B. Arnold; thence along said Arnold line S 37-00 W 2393.2 foot to an iron pin; thence N 37-22 W 057.6 foot to an iron pin; thence N 36-06 W 302.7 foot to an iron pin; thence N 41-23 W 337 foot to an iron pin; thence S 72-03 W 296.2 foot to an iron pin in Tanager Lane; thence along Tanager Lane S 24-86 W 276.9 foot to an iron pin; thence crossing Tanager Lane N 67-48 W 604.2 foot to an iron pin in the center of a branch; thence along the center of said branch, the traversed lines being as follows: N 38-23 E 113.0 feet; N 47-31 E 67.9 feet; N 30-17 E 123.4 foot; N 47-34 E 84.8 feet; N 30-28 W 48.1 feet and N 30-51 E 148.2 feet to a point in the center of said branch; thence N 30-29 E 318.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N 37-49 W 606.6 foot to an iron pin; thence N 46-53 E 861.1 foot to an iron pin; thence N 60-01 E 11.1 foot to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
