The Mortgagor covenants that he is Liwfully saired of the premises assettlebuted described in feet tenula absolute, that he has good right and lawful sutherly to sell, convey, or substitute the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrance whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants is warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagor forward from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:

- 1. That he will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the said note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
