(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION COLUMBIA S.C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND AND NO/100----- DOLLARS

(\$28,000.00), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date, bearing interest as stated in said note, and payable at the rate stated in it as modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is 25 years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be payment or advances to or for the Mortgagor's account, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or on behalf

WHEN PAYING AT THE TIME AND the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns

All that certain place, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Part of Lot 246 and Part of Lot 247, on Plat of Franklin Park, which plat is recorded in the RMG Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book F, Pages 114 and 115, and having according to a survey made by A. Newton Stall, April 7, 1941, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southerly side of Woodvale Avenue, said pin being 25 feet in an easterly direction from the joint front corner of Lots 245 and 246, and then being 1,092.5 feet in an easterly direction from the southeast corner of the intersection of Woodvale Avenue and Byrd Blvd., and running thence along the southerly side of Woodvale Avenue, N; 64-37 E, 95 feet to an iron pin in the joint line of lot 247, thence S. 25-23 E, 205.7 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of lot 247, thence S. 62-34 W, 95.06 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot 246, thence N. 25-23 W, 209.1 feet to an iron pin on the southerly side of Woodvale Avenue, the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or pertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
