That if the premises, or any part thereof, be condemned under any power of entirent domain, or acquired for a public use, the damages, proceeds, and the consideration for such acquisition, to the extent of the full amount of indebtedness upon this mortgage, and the note secured hereby remaining unpaid, are hereby assigned by the Mortgagor to the Morrgagee and shall be paid forthwith to the Mortgagee to be applied by it on account of the indebtedness secured hereby, whether due or not.
