TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, including all built-in stoves and refrigerators, heating air conditioning, plumbing and electrical fixtures, wall to wall carpeting, fences and gates, and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected or fitted in any manner, it being the intention of the parties beretu that all such fixtures and equipment, other than household furniture, be considered a part of the reality.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is seized of the above described premises in fee simple absolute; that the above described premises are free and clear of all liens or other encumbrances, that the Mortgagor is lawfully empowered to convey or encumber the same, and that the Mortgagor will forever defend the said premises unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, from and against the Mortgagor and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

## THE MORTGACOR COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS: -

- 1. That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage will secure the Mortgagee for any additional sums which may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgage; for the payment of taxes, or public assessments, hazard insurance premiums, repairs or other such purposes pursuant to the provisions of this mortgage, and also for any loans or advances that may hereafter be made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgager under the authority of Sec. 45-55, 1962 Code of laws of South Carolina, as amended, or similar statutes, and all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate or rates as that provided in said note unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties and shall be payable at the demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That Mortgagor will keep the improvements on the mortgaged premises, whether now existing or hereafter to be erected, insured against loss by fire, windstorm and other hazards to a sum not less than the balance due hereunder at any time and in a company, or companies acceptable to the Mortgager, and Mortgagor does hereby assign the policy or policies of insurance to the Mortgager and agrees that all such policies shall be held by the Mortgagee should it so require and shall include loss payable clauses in Livor of the Mortgagee, and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give immediate notice thereof to the Mortgagor by registered mail, and should the Mortgagor at any time fail to keep said premises insured or fail to pay the premiums for such insurance, then the Mortgagor may cause such improvements to be insured in the name of the Mortgagor and reimburse itself for the cost of such insurance, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged premises in good repair, and should Mortgagor fail to do so, the Mortgager may, at its option, enter upon said premises and make whatever repairs are necessary and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 5. That the Mortgagee may at any time require the issuance and maintenance of insurance upon the life of any person obligated under the indebtedness secured beirby in a sum sufficient to pay the mortgage debt, with the Mortgagee as beneficiary, and if the mortgage are not otherwise paid, the Mortgagee may pay said promiums and any amount so paid shall become a part of the mortgage debt.
- 6. That Mortgagor agrees to pay all takes and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged premises on or before the due dates thereof and to exhibit the receipts therefor at the offices of the Mortgagor immediately upon payment, and should the Mortgagor fail to pay such takes and assessments when the same shall fall due, the Mortgagor may, at its option pay the same and charge the amounts so paid to the mortgage delit and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as above provided.
- 7. That if this mortgage secures a "construction loan", the Mortgagor agrees that the principal amount of the indebtedness hereby secured shall be disbursed to the Mortgagor in periodic payments, as construction progresses, in accordance with the terms and conditions of a Construction Loan Agreement which is separately executed but is made a part of this mortgage and incorporated herein by reference.
- 8. That the Mortgagor will not further encomber the premises above described, without the prior consent of the Mortgagee, and should the Mortgagor so encounter such premises the Mortgagee may at its option immediately due; and payable and may institute, any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
- 9. That should the Mortgagor alicinate the mortgaged premises by Contract of Sale Bond for Title, or Deed of Conveyance, and the within mortgage indebtedness is not paid in full, the Mortgagor or his Purchaser shall be required to file with the Association an application for an assumption of the mortgage melehredness, pay the reasonable cost as required by the Association for processing the rate on the loan balance entiting at the time of transfer middled by mercasing the interest rate on the said loan balance entiting at the time of transfer middled by mercasing the interest rate on the said loan balance to the maximum rate per annum permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase in interest rate as may be determined by the Association. The Association will notify the Mortgagor or his purchaser of the new interest rate and monthly payments, and will mail him a new pastlood. Should the Mortgagor, or his Purchaser, fad to comply with the provisions of the within particular proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
- 10. That should the Mortgagen fail to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promissory note and the same shall be unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or if there should be any failure to comply with and abide by any by-laws or the charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the Mortgagee, at its option may write to the Mortgager at his last known address giving him thirty (30) days in which to rectify the said default and should the Mortgager fail to rectify said default within the said thirty days, the Mortgagee, may at its option, increase the interest rate on the loan balance for the remaining term of the loan or for a lesser term to the maximum rate per atomic permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase rate as may be determined by the Association. The monthly payments will be admisted accordingly.
- 11. That should the Mortgager fail to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promissory note and should any monthly installment become past due for a period to excess of 15 days, the Mortgagee may collect a "late charge" not to exceed an amount equal to five (5%?) per centum of any such past due installment in order to cover the extra expense incident to the handling of such delinquent payments.
- 12. That the Mortgagor hereby assigns to the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns all the rents issues, and profits accruing from the mortgaged premises retaining the right to collect the same so long as the debt hereby secured is not in arrears of payment, but should any part of the principal indebtedness, or interest, taxes, or fire insurance premiums, he past due and unpaid, the Mortgager may without notice or further proceedings take over the mortgaged premises, if they shall be occupied by a tenant or tenants, and collect said rents and profits actually collected, less the cost of collection and any tenant is authorized upon request by Mortgagor, to make all rental payments direct to the Mortgagor without liability to the Mortgagor until notified to the contrary by the Mortgagor, and should said premises at the time of such default be occupied by the Mortgagor, the Mortgagor may apply to the Judge of the Court of Common Pleas who shall be resident or presiding in the county aforesaid for the appointment of a receiver with authority to take possession of said premises and collect such rents and profits, applying said rents, after paying the cost of collection, to the mortgage debt without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected.
- 13. That the Mortgagee, at its option, may require the Mortgagor to pay to the Mortgagee, on the first day of each month until the note secured hereby is fully paid, the following sums to addition to the payments of principal and interest provided in said note: a sum equal to the premiuns that will next become due and payable on policies of mortgage guaranty insurance (if applicable), fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes, and assessments next due on the mortgaged premises (all as estimated by the Mortgagee) less all sums already paid therefor, diplied by the number of months to clapse before one month prior to the date when such premiums, taxes, and assessments will be due and payable, such sums to be held by Mortgagee to pay said premiums, taxes and special assessments. Should these payments exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgage of taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums, the excess may be credited by the Mortgagee on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor; if, however, said sums shall be insufficient to make said payments when the same shall become due and payable, the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee any amounts recessary to make up the deficiency. The Mortgagor further agrees that at the end of ten-years from the date beroof. Mortgagee may, at its option, apply for renewal of mortgage guaranty or similar insurance (if applicable) covering the balance then remaining due on the mortgage debt, and the Mortgagor may at its option, pay the single premium required for the remaining years of the term, or the Mortgagee may pay such premium and add the same to the mortgage debt in which event the Mortgagor shall gray to Mortgagee such premium payment, with interest, at the rate specified in said promissory note, in equal monthly installments over the termaining payrient period.

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
